IU Budget Redesign

Review of Current State



Phase I: UA Budget Structure and Assessment

- Current UA Assessment allocation model is <u>outdated</u>, <u>lacks data driven</u> <u>approach</u>
- IU working group developed new UA Assessment allocation methodology based on <u>data driven approach</u> for FY26 and beyond
- Development of <u>UA Assessment FY26 figure</u> allows for earlier budget planning by campuses
- UA Assessment requires <u>transparency and alignment</u> regarding unbudgeted financial transactions with campuses to provide <u>more accurate UA cost</u>



Phase II: Engagement at the Campus Level

- Nothing has changed from the current budget model at the campus level
- Campuses are <u>engaging with working groups</u> to assess and develop future budget models unique to each campus
- Each campus is taking its <u>own approach</u> to budget redesign, lead by campus leadership and stakeholders
- Campuses are focused on new budget design rollout FY 27, at the earliest
- Allocation of resources, central versus unit budget control, overall budget management, compensation adjustments, incentives etc. are <u>areas of discussion</u> within the campuses

- Developed and launched an IU Budget Redesign website
 - VPCFO Website
- Continue the working group to collaborate on the Budget Redesign Project
- Engage with external partners to understand best practices and benchmarking

Timeline

- November 2024 Create and launch IU Budget Redesign website
- December 2024 Continue working group meetings on IU Budget Redesign – UA and Campus Financial Leaders
- July 2025 Campuses launch parallel budget model, reviewing impact throughout the fiscal year.
- July 2025 New UA Assessment Allocation model launched
- July 2026 (at the earliest) Campuses officially launch new budget model
- Ongoing Provide update to campus leaders and stakeholders on progress for overall redesign and campus efforts
